Parents will be notified of all field trips requiring private and public transportation prior to their occurrence. This notification will indicate the purpose, the curricular component it addresses, cost, and other requirements for the field trip. Parents are required to submit the consent form and associated fees to the general office **prior** to fieldtrip, otherwise students will **not** be permitted on the fieldtrip.
- School teams and specialty extracurricular clubs: Students will be charged a fee at the beginning of a
 sport season before receiving uniforms or for extra-curricular specialty supplies. These fees will be set
 once costs related to transportation, referee fees, league participation fee, uniform repair and cleaning,
 and specialty supplies are determined.
