The following general fees are recommended for items that are *not covered by the school budget*. Please ensure that any payments are paid as per established deadlines and prior to any field trip or special event. Your prompt attention to this matter would be greatly appreciated.

• Please pay your child's school fees directly from SchoolZone with a Visa or MasterCard. Simply select the "Fees" tab when you log into SchoolZone. <u>Fees must be paid no later than October 4, 2024.</u>

- Field Trips: Field Trips, special guests and other curricular enhancements are booked well in advance. Parents will be notified of all field trips requiring private and public transportation prior to their occurrence. This notification will indicate the purpose, the curricular component it addresses, cost, and other requirements for the field trip. Parents are required to complete the consent form and pay associated fees **prior** to fieldtrip, otherwise students may not be permitted on the field trip.
- School teams and specialty extracurricular clubs: Students may be charged a fee at the beginning of a sport season before receiving uniforms or for extra-curricular specialty supplies. These fees will be set once costs related to transportation, referee fees, uniform repair and cleaning, league participation fees, and specialty supplies are determined.
- **Textbook Caution Fees are not being charged.** However, all students/parents are fully responsible for the full replacement costs (including shipping and handling) of any damaged or lost textbooks, library books, etc.
- Bus passes ETS Student bus passes will be available for purchase by students at the beginning of each month through SchoolZone. (Visa or MasterCard) The price of bus passes is subject to change.
